The General Manager of the Cameroon National Shippers' Council (CNSC) hereby informs shippers, ship-owners, freight forwarders, cargo consolidation operators and other business persons that with effect from **December 1, 2024**, the concept of cargo consolidation ECTN shall be prohibited.

For this purpose, for consolidation cargoes, each consolidation entity shall be required to provide their sub-BL and subsequent documentation namely commercial invoice and freight invoice to have an ECTN established for their cargo. This measure is part of the traceability requirement for goods entering or leaving Cameroon, in accordance with customs procedures.
